nanoHUB Tablet Assistant is a add-in for PowerPoint 2007. The assistant allows selection of pen colors during PowerPoint presentation by using hotkeys. This assistant is designed to work with tablets such as Wacom Cintiq.

Using Wacom Cintiq with nanoHUB Tablet Assistant PowerPoint add-in

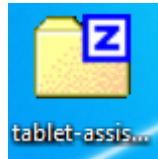
1. Install Wacom Cintiq drivers

- a. Please refer to Wacom user manual.

2. Download and Install Tablet Assistant PowerPoint add-in.

- b. Make sure you have administrator privilege and your computer is connected to Internet



- c. Unzip the installation package

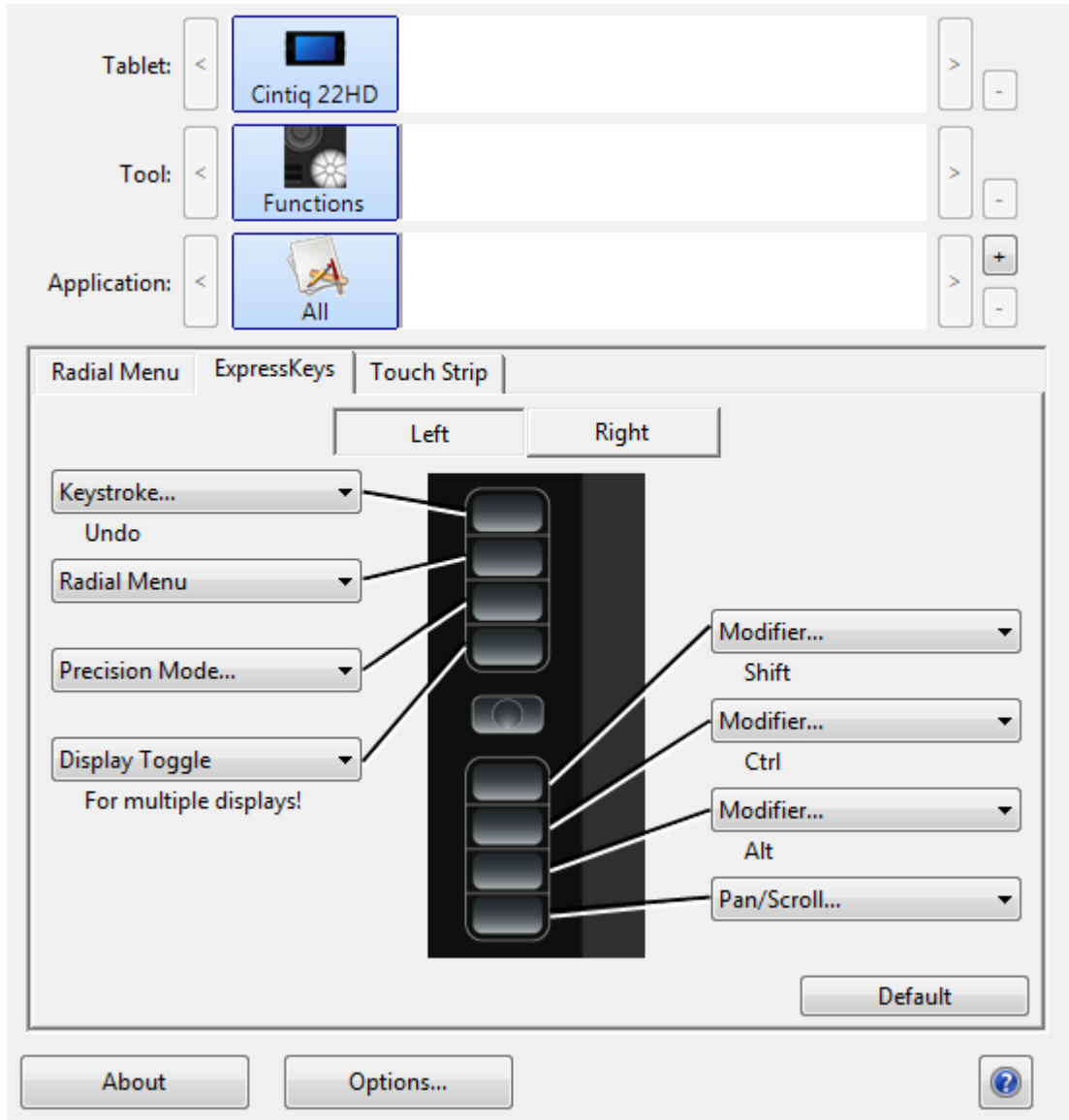

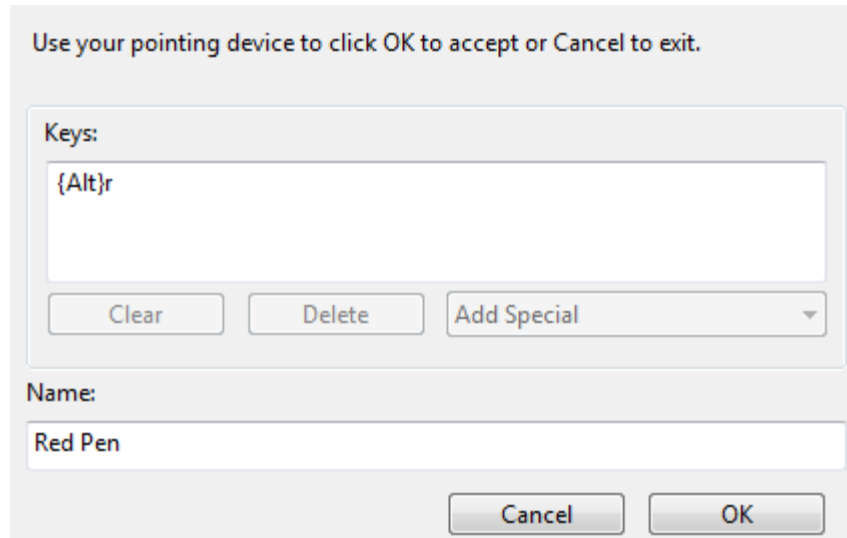

3. Setup Wacom ExpressKeys for PowerPoint

- a. Search “Wacom Properties” in start menu, and start it.
- b. Configure Wacom ExpressKeys



- i. Open the dropdown list of one ExpressKey and select “Keystroke...”



- ii. Click on “Clear” to clear existing keystroke.
- iii. Type in hotkeys for PowerPoint:
 1. Regular PowerPoint Hotkeys:
 - a. Cursor: Control + u
 - b. Pen: Control + p
 - c. Eraser: Control + e
 - d. Clear all drawing: e
 - e. Black screen: b
 - f. Next slide: Right/Down Arrow
 - g. Previous slide: Left/Up Arrow
 2. Advanced hotkeys with Wacom Inking add-in installed:
 - a. Red pen: Alt + r
 - b. Blue pen: Alt + b
 - c. Green pen: Alt + g
 - d. Yellow pen: Alt + y
- iv. Change name to hotkey function name (This is for reference only).
- v. Click on “OK” to save.
- vi. Repeat previous steps to set other ExpressKeys.
