The audience contributes to the success of a speaker when it collectively shows interest or enthusiasm, or can, make the speakers job more difficult.






Stories and Metaphors

Too many facts or talking points	language processing part of our brain gets activated (Broca's or Wernicke's area)

Establish your assertion in 8-14 words

Use "explanatory images"—not decorative or descriptive images—to support each assertion
