

Upload & Migrate Thunderbird to Office 365

You cannot manually [migrate Thunderbird to Office 365](#). There are many reasons behind this which make it an extraordinary process and it can be used in some circumstances like – you have data collected in PST. Because without it the process of Thunderbird to Office 375 is so big that you can lose data in it and it will also require a lot of technical knowledge before doing it.

Steps to upload Thunderbird to Office 365

1. Download Thunderbird to Office 365, install and run the program
2. Click on Add file and choose Autoload or Browse option to add the mailbox.
3. Click on Export to migrate every mailbox simultaneously.
4. Choose Office 365 migration option
5. Enable one mailbox: primary and archive (folder name is optional)
6. Click on next and fill the login credential
